The services CARA provides for victims and survivors of sexual violence and abuse include:

- **ISVA (Independent Sexual Violence Adviser)** support through the criminal justice process and advocacy
- Specialist counselling for **adults**
- Specialist counselling and support for **young people**
- Play therapy for **children under 12**, and support for their **families**
- A **women-only** social group
- **Workshops** and **presentations** on sexual violence for professionals, schools and other agencies
- Support for **relatives of victims and survivors** including parents and carers, partners, siblings and other close family members.

CARA seeks to be an inclusive organisation that actively encourages, supports and values diversity. We try to make our services as accessible and inclusive as we can and to recognise and address discrimination in all its forms.
