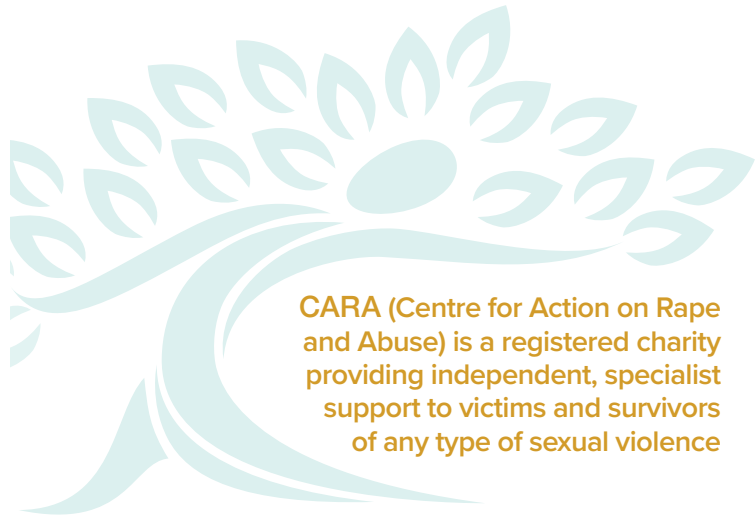


About CARA

Gift Aid
